BARBI TWINS EXPOSE GOVERNMENT ATTEMPTS TO SILENCE FREE SPEECH

In an exclusive interview with newly freed animal rights “terrorist” Darius Fullmer, world famous models and activists the Barbi Twins expose the government’s Animal Enterprise Terrorism Act as an oppressive measure to criminalize free speech and protect corporations who engage in animal cruelty. The AETA targets animal rights activists as terrorists, even if there is no proof of violent intent. Even discussing non-violent protest techniques can land you in jail.
